Eastvale Community Park Rehabilitation Project

Eastvale, CA (June 15, 2017) – Immediately following this year's *Picnic in the Park* event, on June 26th, the Jurupa Community Services District's (JCSD) Parks and Recreation Department will be initiating an extensive rehabilitation project to improve turf conditions at Eastvale Community Park (ECP). The ECP rehab project is expected to last 90-120 days, with a tentative completion date set for October 14th. During this rehab period the functional turf areas (athletic fields) will be unavailable for maintenance work and to provide time for the turf to grow in.

The Eastvale Community Park restrooms, trail, and parking lot **will remain open** during the rehab project. Turf areas will be fenced to prevent unauthorized access during this maintenance period. Local sports user groups have been notified and plans have been made to accommodate leagues at other JCSD park facilities.
