JCSD CELEBRATES WATER AWARENESS MONTH

District Promotes the Need to Conserve Water Resources

MIRA LOMA, Calif., May 13, 2009—At the May 11 Board of Directors meeting, the Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Board adopted a resolution supporting the month of May as “Water Awareness Month.” Since the Governor of the State of California has declared a statewide water shortage emergency, the Board wants to call to the public’s attention that it’s more important than ever to use water wisely.

Since 1989, The California Water Awareness Campaign has designated the month of May as “Water Awareness Month.” The campaign provides the opportunity to promote the need to appreciate, protect and conserve water resources.

The JCSD Board of Directors recently held a conservation workshop to study a long term plan to educate the public about how to conserve water. JCSD also recently held a public seminar, “California Friendly Landscape” that focused on drought tolerant landscaping. The next conservation seminar will be held June 6 at JCSD headquarters on the same topic.
