## **JCSD PARKS AND RECREATION KIDS ZONE CLASSES IN DEMAND**

### **After School Program at Clara Barton is 60% Enrolled in First Day of Registration**

MIRA LOMA, Calif., June 24, 2009 -- Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks and Recreation Department is now offering "After School" and "Off Track" programs at Clara Barton Elementary. In the first day of registration for the new program at Clara Barton, the program was 60% full to capacity.

The "Kids Zone" programs are also offered "Before and After School" and "Off Track" at Rosa Parks Elementary, and "Before and After-School" programs at River Heights Intermediate school are in the planning stages for the end of August. The programs include a variety of recreational experiences including games, arts and crafts, and outdoor play, as well as time for homework and free time. At Rosa Parks Elementary, a new modular unit is being installed to house these programs. JCSD Parks & Recreation staff provide the children with a safe, positive and fun environment in their "Kids Zone" programs.
