JCSD Adds 17 New Classes and Youth Basketball

MIRA LOMA, Calif. – August 5, 2008 – The Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks and Recreation department has just released the latest guide to the fall recreation programs, including the new Youth Basketball League. Descriptions of the more than 50 classes and sports leagues open to children, youth, teens and adults are posted online at www.jcsd.us.

The new Youth Basketball League is designated for boys and girls from ages 6-15. Early bird registration begins September 1, 2008 at www.jcsd.us/registration. The coaching staff will teach fundamentals and techniques during the seasonal competition.

Some of the newest classes include an Introduction to Music for children ages 3-5 as well as art and playschool. Sports classes include teen fitness, karate, soccer and kickboxing. The adult programs have added classes in First Aid and CPR, Marriage 101, scrapbooking, quilting and belly dancing. And a family style tennis academy offers a way for kids and their parents to learn tennis basics together.

During the summer recreation program more than 1,307 children and adults participated in JCSD Parks and Recreation classes. Some of the most popular classes and the first to fill early include Pee Wee Soccer and Tumbling Tots Gymnastics.
