**JCSD Celebrates the Grand Opening of Dairyland Park**

MIRA LOMA, Calif.- September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008- The Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks and Recreation department celebrated the Grand Opening of Dairyland Park on Thursday September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Dairyland Park is located at 14520 San Remo, Corona, CA 92880.

Dairyland Park , with 9.2 acres of open space, includes two dog parks (for small and large dogs) and a water feature. The water feature is designed to collect, treat and recycle the water used in the fountains and play area. A portion of the dog park uses artificial turf to demonstrate additional water conservation. The name “Dairyland” was suggested during an initial community survey prior to the park being built, in order to pay homage to the previous pursuits of the area. Dairyland is located in the Meadowside residential development.
