JCSD CELEBRATES THE GRAND OPENING OF RIVERWALK PARK AND THE EASTVALE TRAIL

MIRA LOMA, Calif., October 31, 2008 --- Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks and Recreation Department celebrated the grand opening of Riverwalk Park and Eastvale Trail on Thursday, October 30, 2008. Riverwalk Park is located at 7674 Soaring Bird Court Corona, CA 92880.



In attendance at the Riverwalk Park Opening were JCSD's General Manager Eldon Horst; Richard Welch, Director of Parks and Recreation; R.M. "Cook" Barela, president of the Board of Directors; Kathie Bogart, Vice President of the Board of Directors; Donna Johnston, Senior Legislative Assistant for Supervisor Tavaglione's office, Riverside County Board of Supervisors; the Riverside County Sherriff's Posse; and Eastvale Cub Scout Pack 803.

The 12.25 acre Riverwalk Park was under construction for two years and now includes a children's play area, fitness station, disc golf course, and a picnic shelter with access to barbecue grills. The Eastvale Trail, currently 1.25 miles long, will be part of the Santa Ana River Trail project and is built with two surfaces – asphalt on the walking/biking portion and decomposed granite on the horse trail. The trail will be approximately 4 miles long at completion.
