### **DIRECTOR BOGART ELECTED PRESIDENT OF JURUPA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT**

#### Director Betty Anderson Elected Vice President for 2008-09

MIRA LOMA, Calif., December 9, 2008--- The Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) elected Director Kathryn Bogart as President and Director Betty Anderson as Vice President of the Board of Directors at the December 8 meeting. The new officers were elected unanimously by the Board, including past President Director R. M. "Cook" Barela, Director Jane Anderson and Director Ken McLaughlin. President Bogart is the first woman to be president of Jurupa Community Services District since the District was founded in 1956.



President Bogart said, "I'm looking forward to the coming year and to the challenges of this growing community in western Riverside County." President Bogart was elected to the JCSD Board of Directors in November 2005 and has served on the Parks & Recreation Committee as well as on the Advisory Committee. She was the first Board member from the new community of Eastvale, where she has lived since 2002.
