JCSD DEDICATES AMERICAN HEROES PARK
Grand Opening Celebration Planned for May 31

MIRA LOMA, Calif., May 27, 2010 --Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks and Recreation Department will celebrate the grand opening of American Heroes Park on Monday, May 31st from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. American Heroes Park is located at 6608 Hellman Avenue in the Eastvale area.

The Memorial Day program will include a flag ceremony, music from the U.S. Navy Band Southwest and dedication speeches from some of Eastvale's community leaders and local dignitaries, including Captain Cynthia Mayman of the Jurupa Valley Sheriff Station and Colonel Thomas Magness, District Commander, Los Angeles district, US Army Corps of Engineers.

During the dedication ceremony, a permanent plaque will be revealed that honors local heroes. The plaque reads:

We dedicate this park in grateful tribute to the public servants, to the defenders of our liberties, to the guardians of our lands and homes...And to all the unsung heroes who have given their all, and sometimes even their lives, for the common good.

American Heroes Park offers soccer fields, basketball courts, tot lot, child play area, dog park, picnic shelters with barbecues and restrooms.
