Half Moon Park Grand Opening Held September 17

MIRA LOMA, Calif., September 22, 2009 ---The Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks & Recreation Department opened its 10th new park, Half Moon Park, on September 17, 2009 at 14383 Cherry Creek in the Eastvale area. The five-acre park includes a baseball field, playground areas with climbing features, slides and swings and picnic areas with covered shelters.
