JCS D OFFERS FREE LANDSCAPE/WATER CONSERVATION CLASS

MIRA LOMA, Calif., October 19, 2009 –Jurupa Community Services District (JCS D) will conduct a free “Landscape/Water Conservation” class at the District Boardroom on Saturday, November 14 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Participants can make a reservation for one of the 50 spots in the class by calling (951) 685-7434 Ext. 108.

The course is targeted to residential customers and covers the basics of irrigation systems, watering and fertilizing, basic landscape design and plant identification. The instructor, Mr. Dave Lannom, is a horticulturist with more than 45 years experience in the industry. Mr. Lannom will discuss garden design, the benefits of using California Friendly plants, sprinkler system basics and irrigation scheduling. Using hands-on exercises and demonstration displays, customers will learn about irrigation hardware and plan-water-soil relationship.

Dave Lannom served as a professor at Mt. San Antonio College for the last 20 years teaching a variety of horticulture classes. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Ornamental Horticulture from California State Polytechnic University and a Masters degree in Agriculture Science. Mr. Lannom also managed Anderson Growers and Deigaard Nurseries.
