

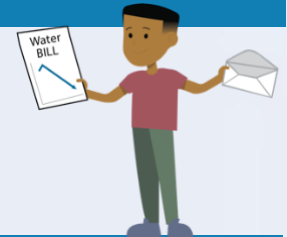


Water Savings Are Part of My Future in 2022!

January 2022

- I will learn [how to read my water bill](#) so I can identify areas where I can save water around the home.



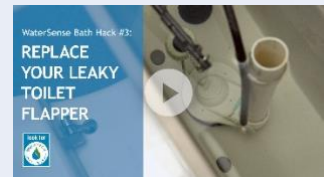
February 2022

- I will show my bathroom some love and swap old plumbing fixtures with [WaterSense labeled models](#).
- I will use the [Product Search Tool](#) to find WaterSense labeled products in the style and price to match my budget.



March 2022

- I will celebrate [Fix a Leak Week](#) March 14-20 by [checking my toilets](#) for silent leaks with a few drops of food coloring in the tank.

- This Earth Day, I will [add mulch around the base of plants and shrubs](#) in my yard to prevent evaporation and improve soil health.



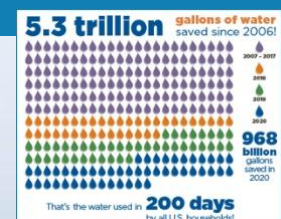
May 2022
