AGENCY INFORMATION

Welcome to the JCSD Parks & Recreation Department!

Thank you for your interest in volunteering with the Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) Parks & Recreation Department. We proudly serve the community of Eastvale, dedicated to enhancing residents' quality of life through exceptional parks, recreation programs, services, and events.

About the JCSD Parks & Recreation Department

Our Department consists of three divisions:

- 1. Administration
- 2. Park/Facility Maintenance and Operations
- 3. Recreation / Community Services

We manage and maintain over 240 acres of parkland, including 15 parks, a 30,000-square-foot Community Center, a 5,000-square-foot Activity Center, and a 2.5-acre special event venue. The JCSD Parks Territory spans approximately 9 square miles within the city of Eastvale, serving about 60,000 residents.

About the Program





The JCSD Park Ambassador Program is a volunteer initiative designed to foster community stewardship and enhance communication between residents and JCSD. As a Park Ambassador, you will:

Conduct biweekly visits to a designated park Identify maintenance needs and opportunities for improvement

Report vandalism and safety concerns

Promote a
positive and
welcoming park
environment

Ambassadors are vital in maintaining the beauty and safety of our parks. This role requires a year-long commitment, including attending an orientation session and quarterly meetings.

What is a Park Ambassador?

A Park Ambassador is a dedicated volunteer representing and advocating for one of our parks or trail systems. As an Ambassador, you will:

- Serve as the eyes and ears of the park, identifying areas for improvement
- Report maintenance needs, vandalism, or safety issues

Your contributions are essential to ensuring a positive experience for all

park visitors.



What a Park Ambassador is NOT

While Park Ambassadors play a crucial role, it's important to understand the limits of this position:

- Not Law Enforcement: Ambassadors do not enforce park regulations. Report violations to park management or law enforcement.
- Not Maintenance Workers: Ambassadors report maintenance needs but are not responsible for performing repairs.
- Not Medical Professionals: In emergencies, contact emergency services immediately.
- Not Confrontational: Ambassadors should not confront park visitors. If safety is compromised, alert the authorities.

Ambassador Requirements

To become a Park Ambassador, you must meet the following criteria:

- Age: Minimum 16 years old
- Availability: Commit to bi-weekly park visits
- Interview: Complete an interview with the Park Ambassador Liaison
- Background Check: Undergo a background check
- Training: Attend a mandatory orientation session

These requirements ensure that Ambassadors are well-prepared and committed to their role.

Applicants Must:

- Be at least 16 years old
- Commit to bi-weekly park inspections and timely submission of observation checklists
- Commit to the program for a minimum of one year
- Attend an orientation and quarterly Ambassador meetings
- Complete a background check
- Maintain communication with JCSD via phone or email
- Possess effective communication skills
- Follow directions from the Park Ambassador
