Over the years, the center has hosted a diverse range of recreational and enrichment programs serving multiple age groups. The renovation will allow for expanded programming and enhanced use of the facility to support community activities, special events, and public reservations.

The JCSD Parks and Recreation Department is an industry leader, nationally accredited by the Commission for Accreditation of Park and Recreation Agencies and recognized for its premier programming. JCSD's recently adopted Master Plan established an updated mission: "Community Through Connection," which emphasizes creating welcoming community spaces that foster social interaction and help residents create lasting memories.

The renovated Harada Neighborhood Center is a 5,400-square-foot facility featuring four activity rooms, centrally located within Harada Heritage Park at the corner of 65th Street and Scholar Way. Since its original opening in 2012, the center has served as a hub for recreational programs, community events, and private reservations for Eastvale residents.

Founded in 1956, the Jurupa Community Services District is a public agency providing services and programs to Jurupa Valley and Eastvale. It is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of five elected representatives from both cities. Serving over 135,000 people in a 40-square-mile area, JCSD provides a variety of community services and programs, including water, sewer, streetlights, frontage landscape maintenance, graffiti abatement, and parks and recreation services.
