

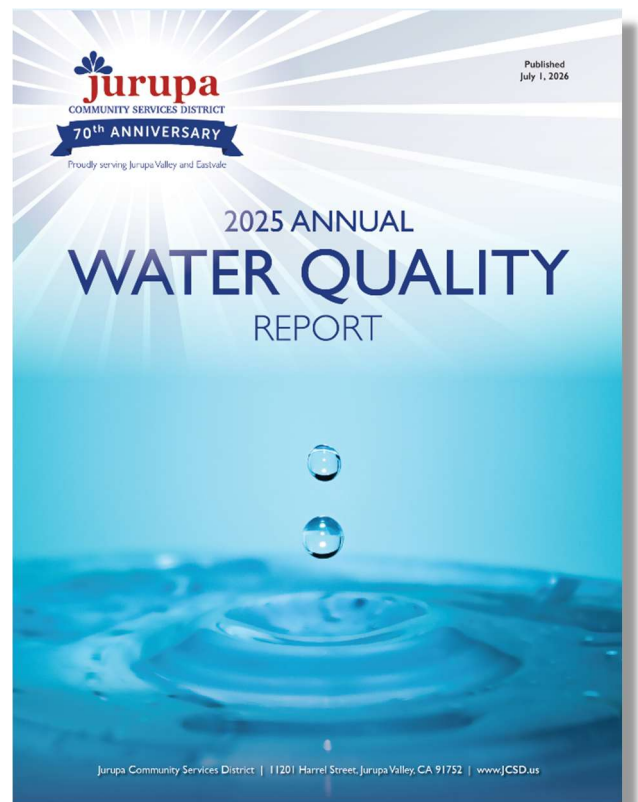

# Jurupa Community Services District's Annual Report Affirms Continued Delivery of Safe Drinking Water

**Jurupa Valley, CA (July 1, 2026)** – Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) has released its 2025 Annual Water Quality Report, also known as the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR). This annual report reflects JCSD's ongoing commitment to transparency, safety, and water quality excellence for the residents of Jurupa Valley and Eastvale.

In 2025, JCSD once again met or exceeded all drinking water standards set by the State Water Resources Control Board and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The report includes results from over 36,000 water quality tests conducted throughout the calendar year, confirming the safety and quality of the water supplied to all residential homes and businesses throughout the District. During testing, JCSD staff monitored water samples for a broad range of potential contaminants to help ensure the ongoing reliability of JCSD's water supply.
